Re: Accredited Service Provider Status

Dear Mr. Wolin:

The Board on Continuing Legal Education has reviewed and approved your application for Accredited Service Provider Status. As an accredited service provider, the continuing legal education activities or courses that you offer are presumptively accredited. You are *required* to file an announcement in advance of the presentation for each of the courses you offer. In addition, you are required to file a detailed report describing the CLE activities you conducted during the prior six months by January 15 and July 15 of each year during this two-year approval period.

The accreditation of these courses extends only to the live, classroom-format presentation of the material, and does not cover any alternative formats of the courses (e.g., audio recordings, video recordings, live broadcasts, teleconferences, videoconferences, online courses, etc.). If you wish to obtain accreditation for an alternative version of these courses, you must submit for approval information on the verifiability of attendance for those formats. If approved, your accreditation would extend to these formats, as well.

You should be aware that a grant of accreditation as an approved service provider may be continued for an additional, consecutive two-year period upon the filing of a new and fully completed application and payment of the required fee before the expiration of this current accreditation period.

Please note that, pursuant to BCLE Reg. 302:7, approved provider status may be revoked at any time if the provider fails to meet the requirements stated in the Board's regulations.

When submitting the course announcement forms, please be sure to request the appropriate credits for civil trial, criminal trial, matrimonial law, or workers' compensation law certification. Please be reminded that credit hours do not include introductory remarks, keynote speeches, luncheon/dinner speeches, breaks, or other non-educational activities.

All providers of New Jersey continuing legal education are required to issue a New Jersey Certificate of Attendance to all attendees upon successful completion of each approved course and are required to maintain records of attendance for a period of not less than three years. Your attendance list should include a sign out, as well as, sign in that is monitored to ensure that an accurate record is being kept of an attorney's full participation in that seminar.
